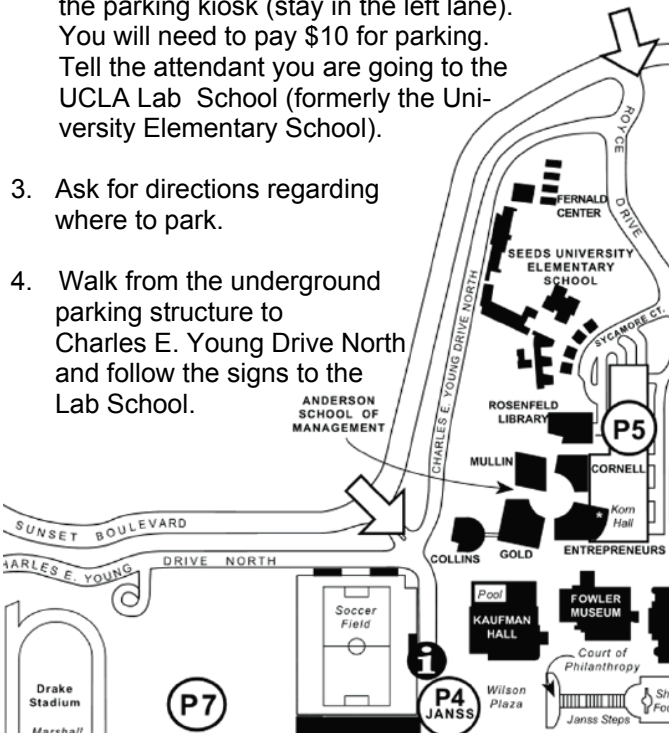

Directions and Parking

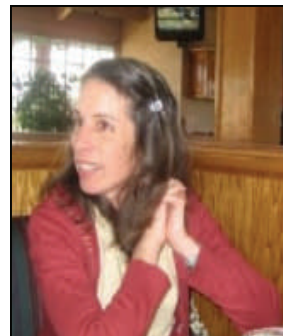
ELIZABETH KHURI CHANDLER
