Using Graphic Novels to Promote Literacy with Preteens and Teens* (Linworth, 2003) and *Connecting Young Adults and Libraries*, 3rd Edition, co-written with Patrick Jones and Tricia Suellentrop.



Tricia Suellentrop is the Teen Services Librarian for the Johnson County Library, Kansas. She is also the recipient of a NACo award for “Read to Succeed” an outreach program to teens in the Juvenile Detention Center. As a YALSA member, she has served on the Popular Paperbacks for Young Adults, the 2004 Presidents Program “The Leader in the Mirror” and the Outreach to Young Adults with Special Needs committees and is currently a member of the 2006 Presidents Program Committee. In 2005, Tricia was selected as one of *Library Journal's* “Movers and Shakers” for her work with teens in the correction system and is also a YALSA certified “Serving the Underserved” Trainer. Tricia is a co-author of the 3rd edition of *Connecting Young Adults and Libraries* with Patrick Jones and Michele Gorman.
