**Maureen Wade**

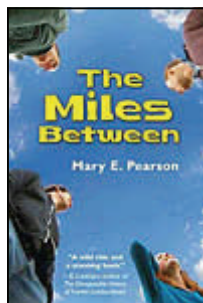
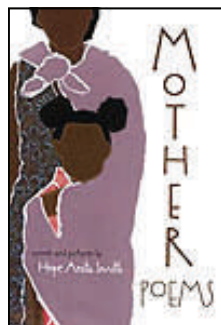
